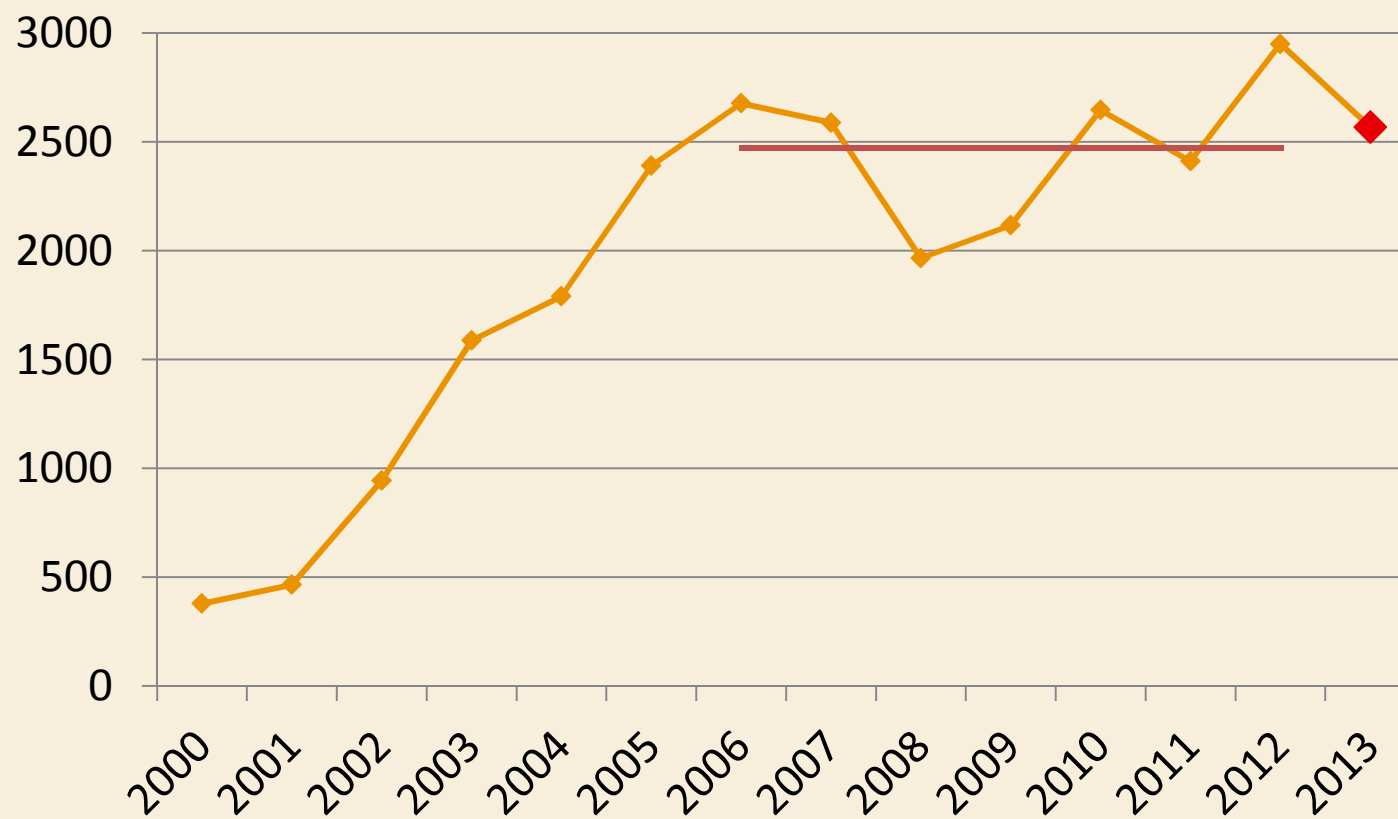

- 2568 Reports handled

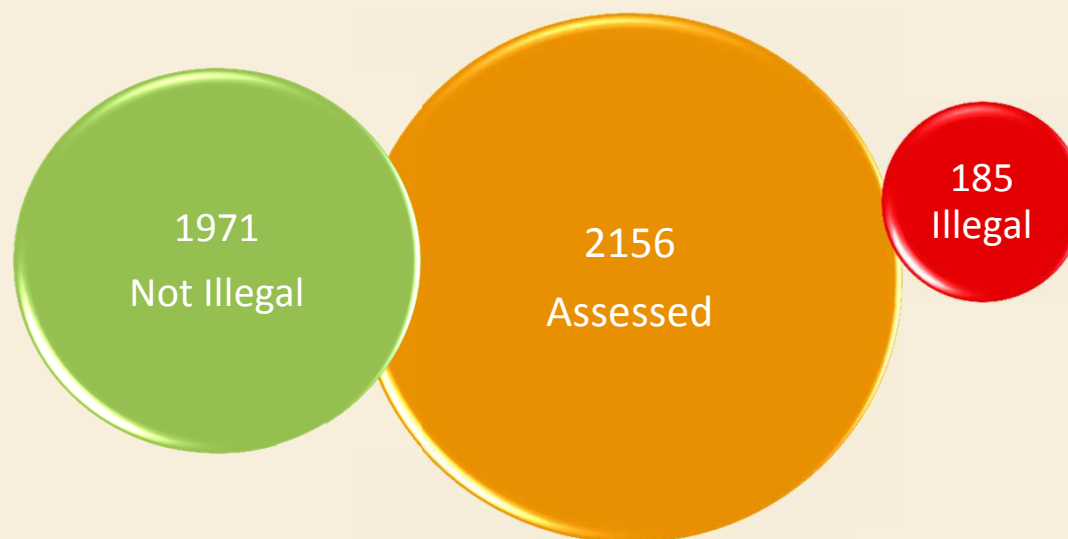


Overview of Hotline Report 2013



- 412 of 2568 reports not fully assessed
 - 143 Insufficient detail
 - 55 Already removed by ISP
- 2156 Fully Assessed Reports

- Breakdown of Illegal Reports

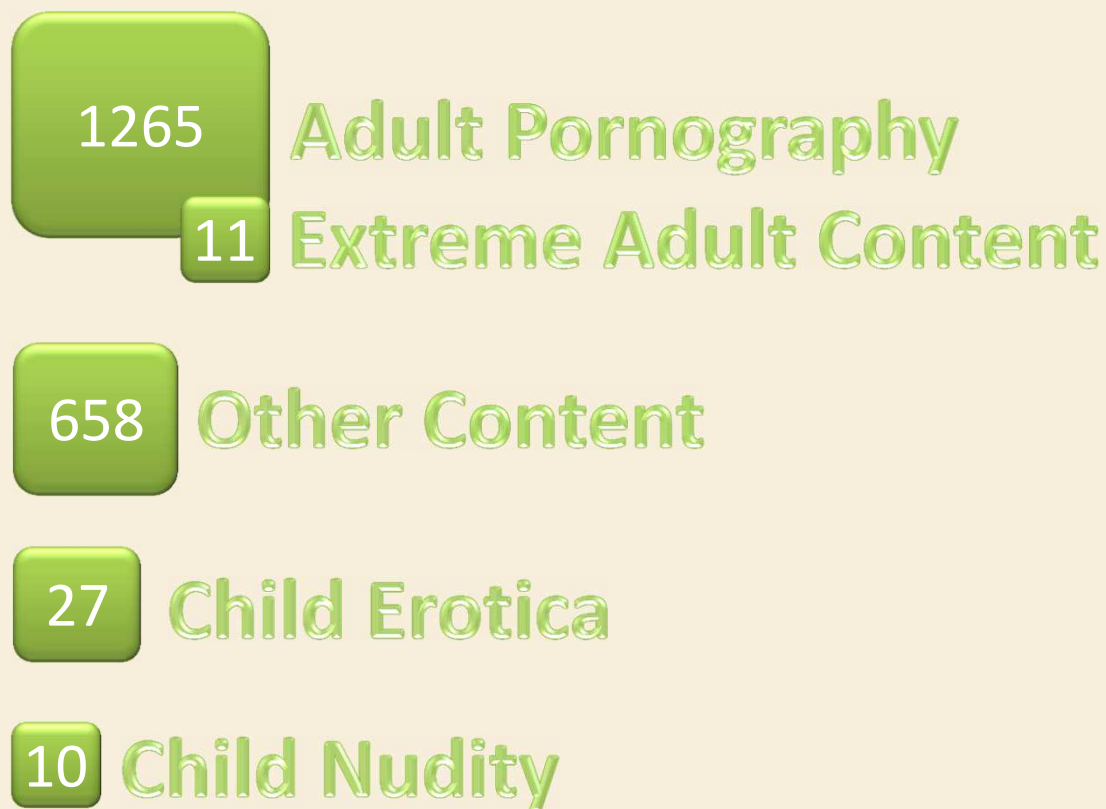

- Why so many assessed not illegal?

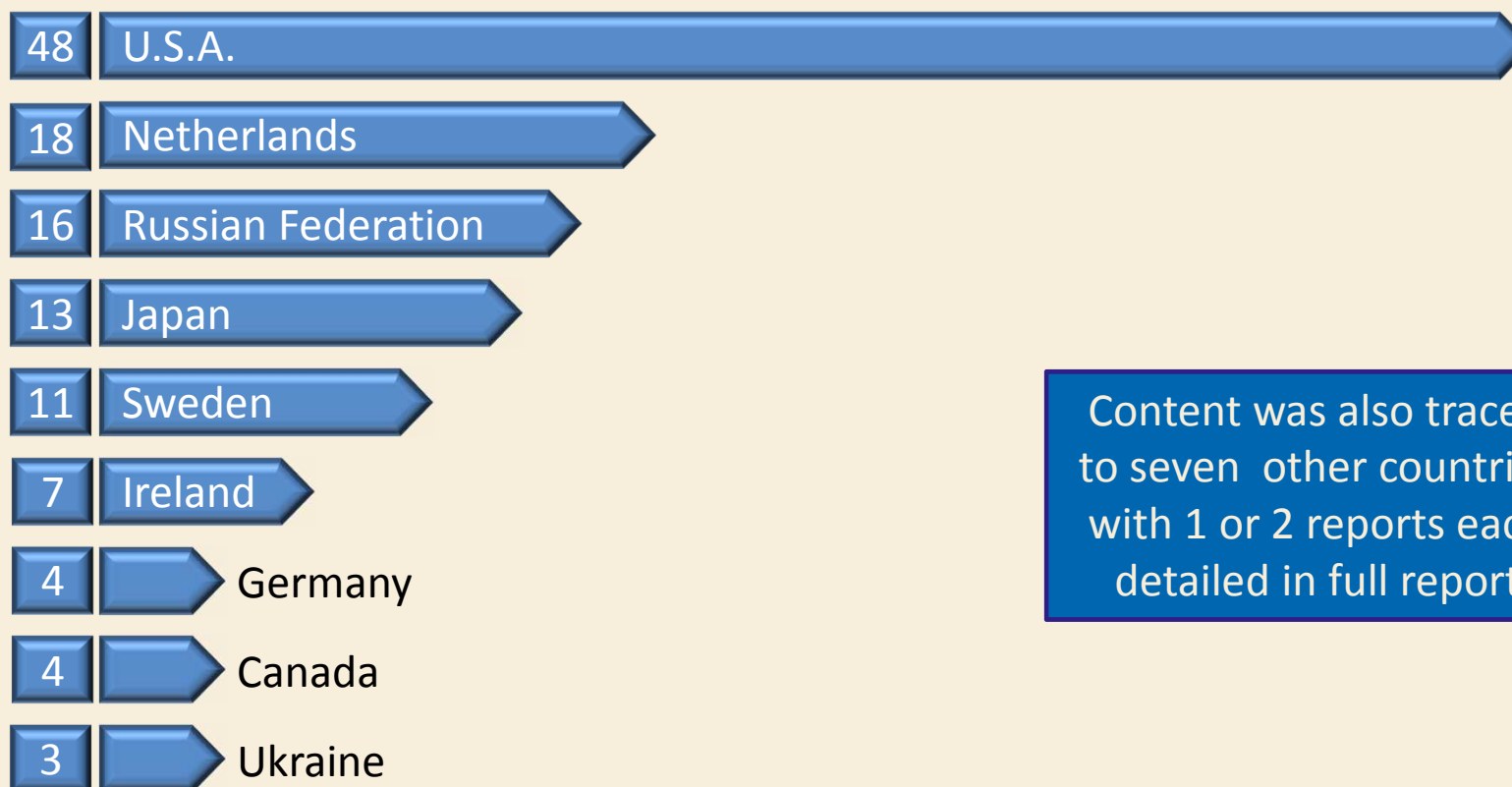
